Policy on Utilizing College Campuses for Conferences

Alpha Phi Omega is an intercollegiate, inclusive, international service organization committed to empowering students toward becoming servant-minded leaders in their respective communities.

To continually enrich the intercollegiate character and inclusive character of Alpha Phi Omega, and to strengthen the existing relationship between Alpha Phi Omega chapters as non-profit entities and their respective campuses that they serve, Alpha Phi Omega-Region C shall grant preferences to college campuses over and against any other corporate/business entities (hotels, conference centers, etc) in its utilization of college campuses for interchapter relations/conference hosting, workshop/breakout session room reservations, banquet location reservations.

Whenever there are multiple site options to host any area/region conference, or conference meant to gather the chapters of Region C together, this policy of preference toward secondary institution/college applies, but is not limited to, ordinary comparisons of venue, pricing, availability, travel, transportation.
