Whereas, the experience of hosting a Regional Conference is often positive for the host 1 chapter(s), enhancing the leadership, friendship, and service experiences of all of the brothers of 2 3 the host chapter(s); therefore, be it 4 Resolved, that Region C create three conference areas, with such areas defined as: 5 6 7 East-Central: Northeast Kansas (Emporia, and areas northeast of Emporia), Missouri (areas north and/or east of Springfield), and Illinois. 8 9 Northwest: Colorado, Wyoming, Nebraska, Northwest Kansas (areas northwest of 10 Emporia). 11 12 13 South: Oklahoma, Arkansas, South Kansas (areas south of Emporia), and Missouri (Springfield and areas southwest of Springfield); and be it further 14

Resolved, that a rotation be established, such that in each six-year period, the chapters of each area will have priority in extending bids to host the Region C conference once, rotating through the East-Central, Northwest, and South, in that order; and be it further

Resolved, that three months prior to the first Regional Business Meeting at each National Convention, the Region C Chair will notify the Chapter Presidents and Section Chairs in an area, following the rotation previously established, that they have the first right to extend a bid to host the Region C Conference; and be it further

25 Resolved, that two months prior to the first Regional Business Meeting at each National Convention, statements of interest from area chapters are due to the Region C Chair, who then 26 27 has one week to compile and send the potential bids to all of the Region C Section Chairs. The 28 Section Chairs have one week to express concerns with any potential bids, provided that the concerns are clearly related to the chapter(s) ability to host the event, to the Region C Chair. The 29 Region C Chair then has two weeks to discuss the concerns with the interested chapter(s), thus 30 31 allowing the bidding chapter(s) to assure the Region C Chair that the potential limitations have been considered and a plan exists to overcome them; and be it further 32

Resolved, that in the case that no chapter(s) express interest by the two-month deadline, then the Region C Chair will contact all of the Chapter Presidents and Section Chairs in Region C, informing them of their ability to extend a bid at the National Convention to host the Conference; and be it further

Resolved, that one month prior to the first Regional Business Meeting at each National 39 Convention, if the Region C Chair believes that a Section Chair has raised an issue with a 40 potential bid that was not resolved in the two-week window, the Region C Chair may rule that 41 bid ineligible. In the case that the only potential bid under consideration is declared ineligible, 42 then the Region C Chair will contact all of the Chapter Presidents and Section Chairs, informing 43 them of their ability to extend a bid at the National Convention to host the Conference; and be it 44 further 45 46 Resolved, that the rotation will continue uninterrupted, regardless of where the conference is 47 actually held in any given year; and considering that the 2010 Region C Conference is located in 48 49 the East-Central area, be it further 50

Resolved, that the rotation will be in effect for the 2012 Conference, which shall be located in the Northwest Area.
